Check in at Aspö



To Aspö, an island with about 500 inhabitants, you can take less than half an hour with the Aspöfärjan from Handelshamnen in

Karlskrona. There is plenty to do here and if you have a bike with you, Aspö offers two mile-long rounds on winding roads that take you deep into the island's summer wilderness. Along the way you can cool off at the island's bathing area or take a lovely dip from the cliffs and if you are interested in art you can stop at one of the malls on the island. Sydostleden



Take a holiday with your bike and explore the South of Sweden on a 270 kilometer long Bicycle Route. Sydostleden offer you a varied nature

experience from the bike saddle. Choose to start the trip in the deep forests of Småland in the north, along the coast in the south or which ever place you choose along the route! Sydostleden is divided into seven sections. Choose to cycle one section at a time, merge multiple sections or cycle the whole trail in a sweep! The trail offers a variety of cultural experiences through a varied nature, be sure to make time for many stops along the way. In Belkinge there are 2 sections. Fridafors-Karlshamn: do not miss the Abu museum in Svängsta.

There are many accommodation alternatives along the route if you want to overnigt.

It tells the story of the Abu factory, which stopped manufacturing watches and taxi meters to instead concentrate on fishing equipment. At Svängsta the landscape changes character from woodland to open countryside. The countryside along the coast is the lowest stage in Blekinge.

The port and market town of Karlshamn was founded in 1664. It was in Karlshamn that Kristina from Duvemåla and her Karl Oskar (from the novels by Vilhelm Moberg) boarded the brig Charlotta, which took them across the

Atlantic to America. The Emigrant Monument in the Harbour Park has been erected in memory of those who emigrated from Sweden. In the harbour there is a maritime museum.

With its location by the sea, Karlshamn is a popular bathing and holiday destination. An open-air bath with exciting new architecture was opened in 2015. From the centre there are boats to the island fortress of Kastellet and the other islands in the archipelago.

Karlshamn-Sölvesborg: An old, solid stone arch bridge crosses the River Mörrumsån. Mörrum is the centre of the river's famous salmon fishery which has been well known since the thirteenth century.

Continue cycling towards the villages of Mörrum and Norje. By the time you reach Norje you are actually located in the very middle of Sydostleden trail, this is where you find the halfway point.


In the city of Sölvesborg the trail takes you over the 760 meter long Sölvesborg Bridge, which connects Listerlandet with the town, is Europe's longest pedestrian and bicycle bridge. In the area around the main square, Stortorget you will find many shops, restaurants and cafés.

Lake Halen & Sweden Southern Wilderness



In the nature reserve
Halen you can experience
a forest and
lake-dominated
"wilderness" within
walking distance of

Olofströms and Jämshög's urban areas. Here are

rich opportunities for different types of outdoor life as well as high nature values. Lake Halen is Blekinge's largest lake and about half of its surface is included in the nature reserve. There are hiking trails, running tracks, riding trails, rest areas and wind shelter. The area is crossed by roads where you can ride a bike and even drive a car. In Halen there are bathing areas for people as well as for horses and dogs. The lake is popular among canoeists and is part of a larger lake system along with the neighboring lakes Immeln, Filkesjön and Raslången. Directly adjacent to the nature reserve there is camping as well as hotel and restaurant. Several different local associations are active in the Halen area. such as scouts, orienteers, leisure club, boat club and riding club.

Old railway embankment trail, Halmstad -Karlshamn



The old railway
embankment trail unites
Halmstad's and
Karlshamn's attractive
coastal areas, takes you
through varied

landscapes and follows Fylle river up through the Simlångs valley, passing the beautiful lakes Bolmen and Åsnen and ending with a long distance along the Mörrum river - one of the world's leading salmon fishing waters. The trail, which is about 250 km, passes about 40 old railway station environments, all more or less intact.

The railway embankment trail has become an all-activity trail - for wheelchair users, horseriders (on certain routes), roller-skiers, hikers, inliners, regular skiers in winter - and of course cyclists.

Along the trail there are hotels, hostels, campsites and holiday villages. Provisions are available in every major community and it is possible to rent bicycles in several places. You will pass many attractions + suggestions for return bike trips.

The small roads of the trails have a good standard, almost everyone is paved. The embankment is also paved a few miles at each end towards Halmstad and Karlshamn respectively. Otherwise, the embankment consists of good gravel roads. You can use any bike you want along the trail, but most comfortable is a model with fairly wide tires. The embankment trail isn't almost at all hilly and

lies beautifully in the terrain.

Underwater trail in Kollevik



Want to know more about life under the surface?
Here is the chance to learn more about plants and animals that live in the water just outside the

coast of Blekinge. The snorkeling trail is an "underwater path" with information plates on the bottom that can be read from the surface and is situated at Kollevik bathing area in Karlshamn. The idea of the snorkeling trail is to pay attention to the marine ecosystems and increase the interest in life below the surface. The snorkeling trail goes through various marine landscapes such as sand and rock bottom. The information is easy to understand and describes the most common species outside Blekinge's coast, but also large-scale Baltic sea problems such as eutrophication, boat bottom paints and overfishing.

The trail is divided into simpler parts in shallow water and a slightly more difficult part on deeper water, however, max. 3 meters. The proximity to the beach makes it possible to interrupt the snorkeling whenever you want. Children should snorkel in the company of an adult.






