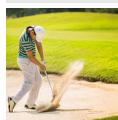

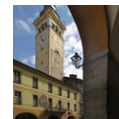

Cuneo is known as "the town of seven sieges", named so after the French who besieged the town several times during the War of Austrian Succession. Despite this, Cuneo was strong and successfully resisted until the Napoleonic Wars, when the city was finally conquered. It was only in 1959, after the restoration of Kingdom of Sardinia and unification of Italy, that Cuneo became the capital of the province and main hub for the numerous attractions in the area.

Use the town of Cuneo as a base of operations to explore the whole region. Visit Saluzzo, the "Siena of Piedmont", or Alba, the Medieval "town of a hundred towers" for unrivaled historic architecture against a mesmerizing backdrop of snow-covered mountains. Travel to Frabosa Soprana or Limone Piemonte for top-notch skiing and winter activities. The mix of small-town charm and vast mountain scenery make Cuneo a top destination that is sure to please all who come.

Piazza Galimberti



Piazza Galimberti was named after the Italian Resistance hero, Tancredi (Duccio) Galimberti in 1945. On the walls here one can see the tablet with the famous quotes from Galimberti. The square took 50 years to build in its neoclassical style. It is one of the most beautiful places in Italy and also a great source of pride for Cuneo where a number of events takes place each year. It also features as an outdoor market.

Limone Piemonte Comprensorio Sciistico



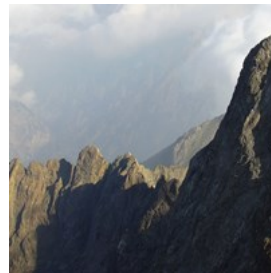
Limone Piemonte is a municipality of Cuneo which is famous for its skiing activities. It is actually one of the oldest ski areas in Italy. The

Sanctuary Madonna della Riva

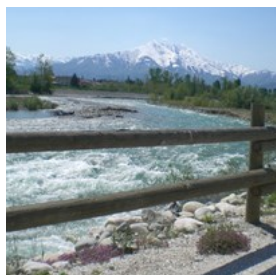
