






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# THE CITY

Luleå was founded in 1621, however, the city's history is considerably older than that. Luleå was originally situated around the medieval church in Gammelstad "Old Town", 9 km inland. The amount of shipping through the harbour in Gammelstad increased during the 17th century, and because of the ongoing land rise, a deeper harbour was required. The city was then moved towards the sea to its present location, Luleå "New Town". The "Old Town" in Gammelstad continued to grow as a church town--today, a popular tourist attraction listed as a World Heritage Site, the Gammelstad Church Town.

# World Heritage Gammelstad Church Town



The old town of Luleå – Gammelstad Church Town – located 9 km outside of Luleå city center, is the largest and best preserved church

town in Sweden. This unique cultural environment with its medieval church and 408 small church cottages was added to Unesco's world heritage list in 1996. Through history visitors to the church travelling from afar, have been staying overnight in the cottages ever since the 16th century.

In the middle of the town you will find Nederluleå church – It is richly decorated with one of the finest altar screens in the country, dating back to 1520's.

Don't miss Hägnan in Gammelstad – an open-air museum showing an historical environment with buildings from the 18th until the 20th century. Hägnan gives a realistic picture of how an old village along the coastline of Norrbotten could look like.

The church town is a popular destination for exursions and perfect for picnics.

# Walk on the Ice




Have a walk on the ice – and tell your friends you have been walking on water. Luleå's arctic location makes it is possible when the Bay of

# Hiking in Luleå



Luleå has a wide range of hiking trails, each with its unique character and showcasing distinctive parts of Luleå's natural environment. Several are

within walking distance of the city center, others are easily reached by bus or bicycle. If you have access to a car, then the possibilities are endless. Hiking in Luleå is almost like strolling through the history of this unique city. For instance, you can begin by hiking across the large shingle fields on Bälingeberget – the first spot to rise from the sea, following land uplift after the recession of the inland ice sheet. At the time, Bälingeberget was just in islet in the middle of the sea and the waves shaped the rocks that now make hiking on the mountaina fascinating experience.

Continue through the history of Luleå by visiting the place we now call Gammelstad Church Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and once the centre of Luleå, before the city was moved in the 17th century. Today, it is a popular tourist destination and there are also many rare birds in the area. Here, you

can hike on what was once the seabed, now a beautiful forest with pleasant walking paths. When you have made your way to the modern city of Luleå, on the peninsula by the coast, you will find many other amazing areas to explore on foot. When people moved here in the 1600's, they also began exploring the surroundings. This helped create several excellent hiking trails near the city centre, such as one of the locals' favourites, the trail around Hertsöträsk.

Luleå has a lot to offer hikers. We have collected our favourite destinations in our hiking guide and we hope you will enjoy them just as much as we do.



## Luleå Cathedral



The Luleå cathedral was build after the great fire in Luleå city in 1887. The fire completely destroyed the old church on the site, Gustaf's church,

which was from the late 1700s.

Luleå cathedral is built in brick in neo-Gothic style. When the church was opened in 1893, it was called Oscar Fredrik's church after King Oscar II. In 1904, the Luleå cathedral became Luleå's foundation.

The architect who designed the cathedral was Adolf Emil Melander, Stockholm. The cathedral is cross-shaped, 54 meters long and 35 meters wide. The church tower is just over 60 meters high.

Architect Knut Nordenskjöld was behind the new design. Wall paintings and star decorations in the ceiling were removed and the entire interior was painted white. Remains of the old style still

# appear in church entrances.

Mountain Bälingeberget is an easily reached nature reserve where traces of the inland ice are clearly visible; remains include large



# Hiking in Luleå



Luleå has a wide range of hiking trails, each with its unique character and showcasing distinctive parts of Luleå's natural environment. Several are

within walking distance of the city center, others are easily reached by bus or bicycle. If you have access to a car, then the possibilities are endless. Hiking in Luleå is almost like strolling through the history of this unique city. For instance, you can begin by hiking across the large shingle fields on Bälingeberget – the first spot to rise from the sea, following land uplift after the recession of the inland ice sheet. At the time, Bälingeberget was just in islet in the middle of the sea and the waves shaped the rocks that now make hiking on the mountaina fascinating experience.

Continue through the history of Luleå by visiting the place we now call Gammelstad Church Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and once the centre of Luleå, before the city was moved in the 17th century. Today, it is a popular tourist destination and there are also many rare birds in the area. Here, you

can hike on what was once the seabed, now a beautiful forest with pleasant walking paths. When you have made your way to the modern city of Luleå, on the peninsula by the coast, you will find many other amazing areas to explore on foot. When people moved here in the 1600's, they also began exploring the surroundings. This helped create several excellent hiking trails near the city centre, such as one of the locals' favourites, the trail around Hertsöträsk.

Luleå has a lot to offer hikers. We have collected our favourite destinations in our hiking guide and we hope you will enjoy them just as much as we do.




